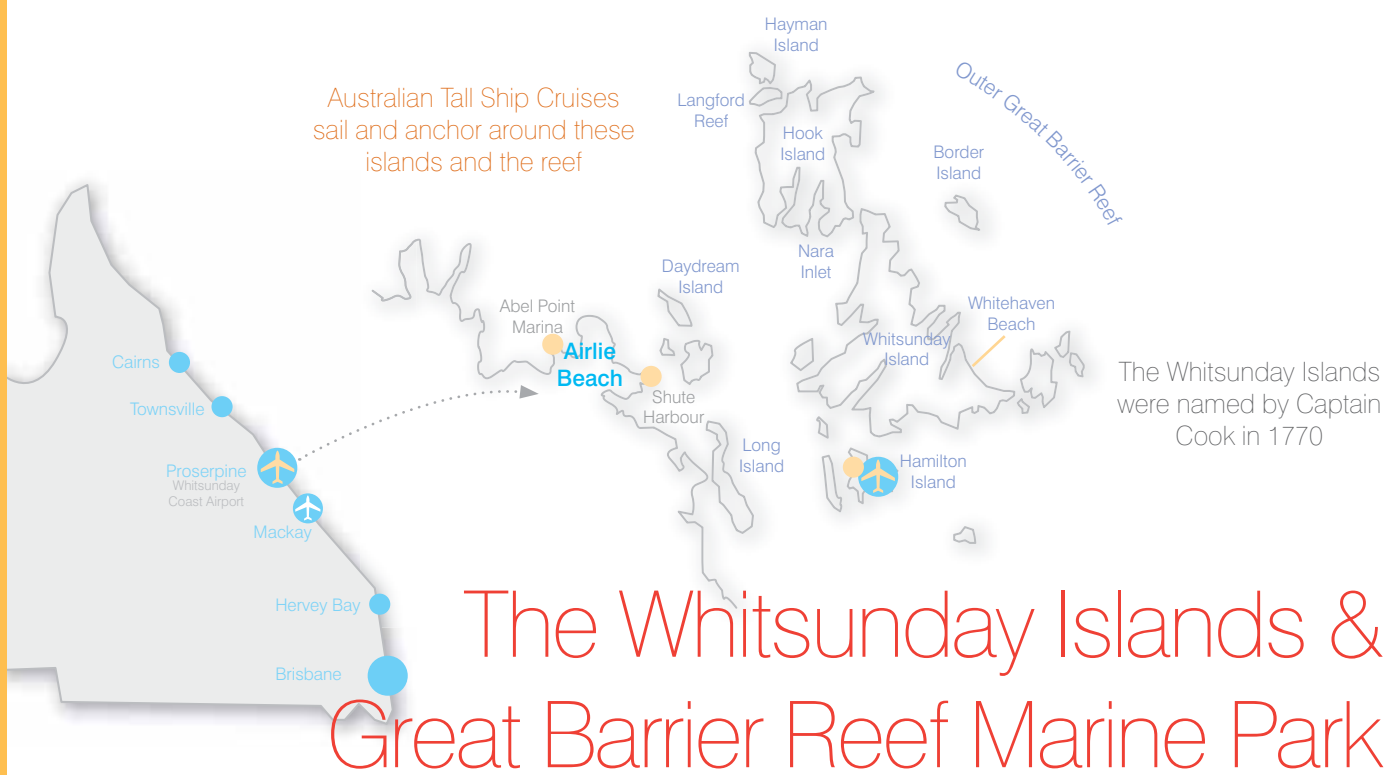

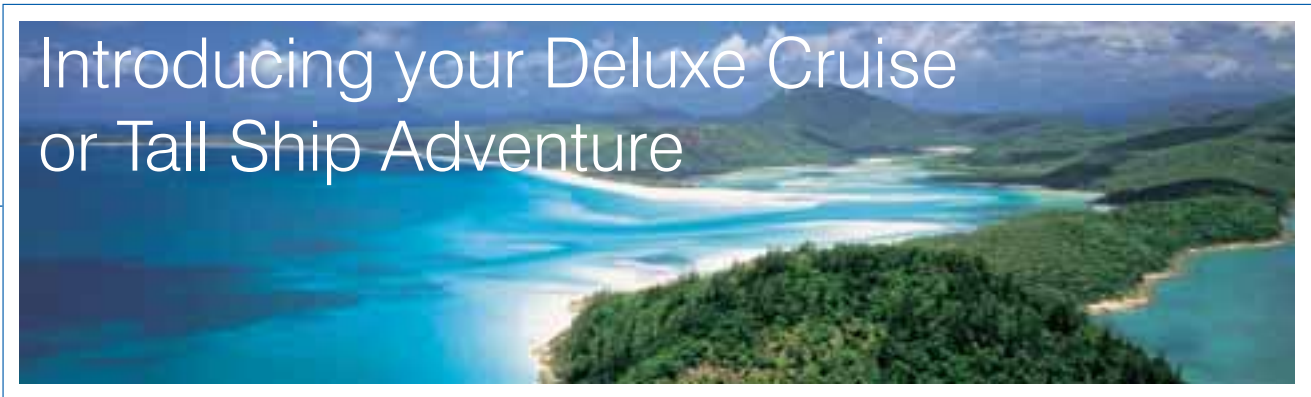

While underway, sit back and take in the extraordinary scenery and, if you feel inclined, help the crew ... pull the lines ... trim the sails ... and learn about sailing.

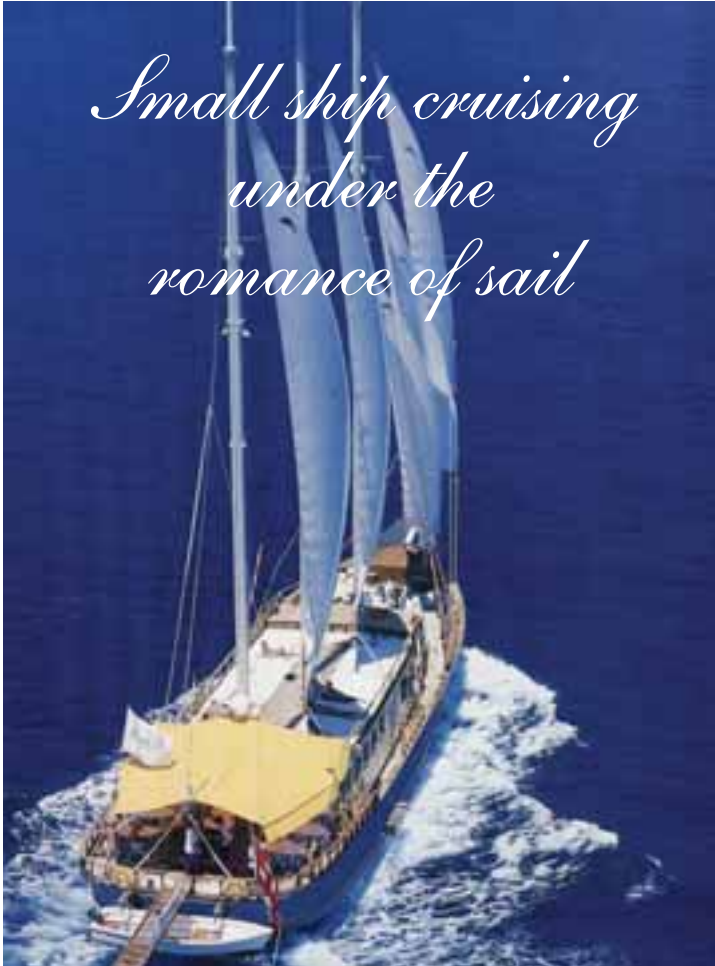

Solway Lass is a 2 Masted Topsail Schooner built in Holland in 1902 offering Whitsunday Island cruises. This magnificent Tall Ship is maintained in beautiful condition and reflects the crew's love and respect for this traditional, century-old sailing vessel. Life on Board is fun, and you may even find the crew dressing as pirates.

Features include:

Solway Lass is square rigged with 11 sails, 11 air conditioned Cabins appointed in oak and cedar with brass lamps, double beds or single bunk beds with personal reading lamps, separate male/female Bathrooms with vanities, large mirrors, 240 volt power and hot showers. Comfortable Bar and Lounge area, mid ship Shaded Dining / Viewing Deck, Bow Net to lay in and listen to the water lap the bow as we sail peacefully along, Tarzan Rope Swing, for those feeling courageous. Our professional crew will prepare fresh, healthy and plentiful meals.

Guests have plenty of deck space to sunbake or relax undisturbed.



- Served as decoy Q-Ship for Britain in WWI.
- The name Solway Lass comes from Scotland where in the 1920s she carried granite to ports like Liverpool. The granite was used for Cobblestone Streets.
- Served as a supply ship for Germany in WWII.
- Worked as cargo ship around Fiji Islands during the 1970s.

Sailing & Accommodation Ideas

Whether your preferred style of accommodation is an Island Resort, or on the mainland, in 3 or 4 star Hotels, Apartments, B&B or Backpackers, there are sailing and accommodation options available.

Why not spend a week or longer in Airlie Beach & The Whitsundays ... we are sure you will appreciate how relaxing and beautiful the area is.

The following ideas can be tailored to suit your needs, extended or reduced depending on your holiday plans.

9 Nights – Whitsunday Magic . Fly to Proserpine on Friday morning, arrive in Airlie Beach at 1pm and check in for sailing. At 3pm our Courtesy Bus will take you to Whitsunday Magic for a 6 night deluxe cruise to the Outer Great Barrier Reef and around the islands, returning to Airlie Beach Thursday at 11am. Spend three nights in Airlie Beach before flying home Sunday. This option can be adjusted slightly, we can drop you at Daydream Island at 9am on Thursday and you spend three nights on the resort. Sunday, take a ferry to Hamilton Island or Shute Harbour for your flight home.

6 Nights – Solway Lass. Fly to Proserpine on Saturday morning, arrive in Airlie Beach at 1pm and check in for sailing. Leave your luggage in our office, and go for a swim at the lagoon or take a walk around Airlie Beach. At 6pm our Courtesy Bus will transfer you to Solway Lass for a 3 night cruise around the Whitsunday islands, returning Tuesday at 4.30pm. Then spend three nights in Airlie Beach with a day relaxing at the tropical lagoon; a visit to Cedar Creek Falls; or just enjoying our wonderful friendly village atmosphere. Fly home Friday.

Week-end Escape – Whitsunday Magic. Fly to Proserpine on Friday morning, arrive in Airlie Beach at 1pm and check in for briefing. At 3pm our Courtesy Bus will transfer you to Whitsunday Magic for a 3 night deluxe cruise to the Outer Barrier Reef & Whitehaven Beach. Monday morning at 11am, we call into Hamilton Island Marina, and you can choose to fly home today, or extend your week-end by spending a night or two on Hamilton Island before flying home.

Honeymoon – Whitsunday Magic. Fly to Hamilton Island on Sunday, overnight on the island and at 11am on Monday morning board Whitsunday Magic at Hamilton Island Marina for a deluxe cruise around the Whitsunday Islands and Whitehaven Beach. At 9am on Thursday transfer to Daydream Island; spend two nights at the resort. Saturday take a ferry to Hamilton Island or Shute Harbour for your flight home. Alternatively, on Thursday morning, hop off at Daydream Island, and catch a ferry to Hamilton Island and spend two nights on the island before flying home.

Group Charters

At Australian Tall Ship Cruises we can organise private charters for any special event. Solway Lass is available during daylight hours on Saturdays for day charters. Weddings and Birthdays are very popular. For day charters, we can carry 75 guests on Solway Lass and 100 guests on Whitsunday Magic.

With extended charters we can tailor schedules to meet customer needs. Solway Lass and Whitsunday Magic can sail together as a flotilla. We can sleep up to 75 guests.





Travel to Whitsundays

Airlie Beach is located 1150kms north of Brisbane & 630kms south of Cairns.

By ROAD – follow the Bruce Highway. The turn off to Airlie Beach is at Proserpine.

Express Coach services are available with Greyhound or Premier.

All major Car Hire companies have agencies in Airlie Beach.

By PLANE – flights are available from Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne to Whitsunday Coast Airport (near Proserpine), or Hamilton Island Airport.

TRANSFERS – Whitsunday Coast Airport. Coach, Shuttle, or Taxi services meet each flight, and it takes approximately 35 minutes to get to Airlie Beach. From Hamilton Island Airport transfers to Shute Harbour are available with Blue Ferries, or via a light plane to the mainland with Island Air Taxis. Then transfer to Airlie Beach via Coach or Taxi.

Departures

SOLWAY LASS departs & returns to I from Abel Point Marina at Airlie Beach.

WHITSUNDAY MAGIC. The Reef Cruise departs from Abel Point Marina at Airlie Beach, while the Island Cruise departs from Hamilton Island or Shute Harbour (11kms from Airlie Beach). For guests flying, this provides options for flying into or out of Hamilton Island Airport or Whitsunday Coast Airport on the mainland. You may find the best option is to fly into Whitsunday Coast Airport and out from Hamilton Island Airport or vice-versa.

Tour Inclusions & Prices

We supply experienced, fully qualified, professional crew. Meals: All meals, while on tour, plus Morning and Afternoon Tea, Pre-dinner Platters, Deserts, Tea and Coffee. We will cater for all special dietary needs. Transfers from Airlie Beach to board your tour at Abel Point Marina or Shute Harbour, snorkel gear, linen, accommodation in twin, double or share air conditioned cabins.
